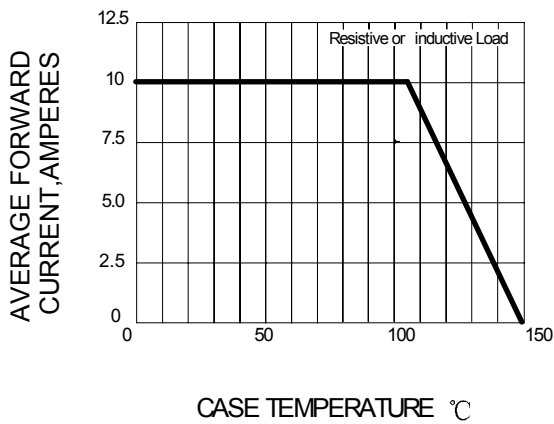

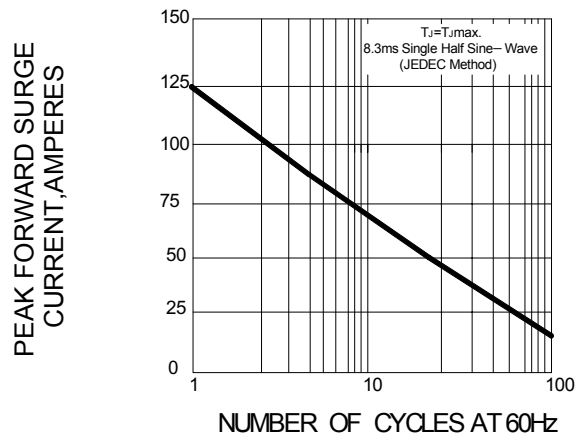

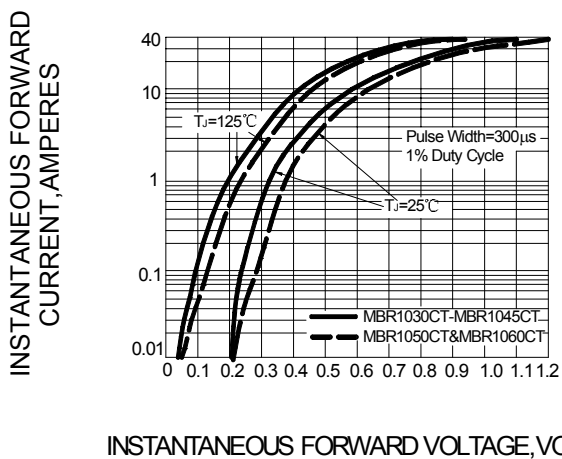
**FIG.1 – FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE**



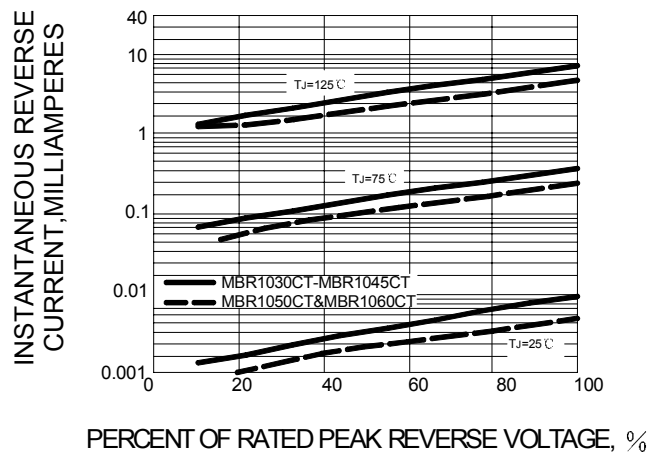
**FIG.2 – MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG**



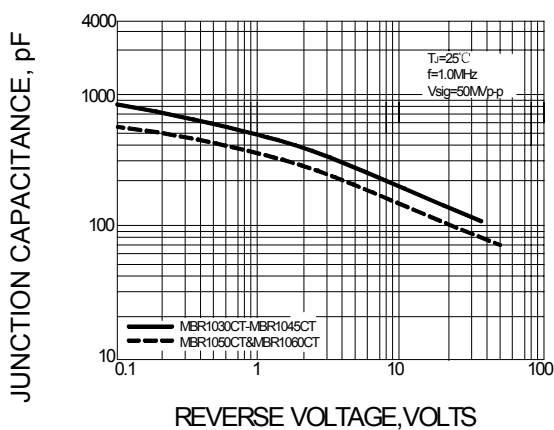
**FIG.3 – TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC PER LEG**
